Trustee's Minutes

First Congregational Church UCC Trustee Meeting Minutes Wednesday November 16, 2011

I. Open Meeting

Tom called the meeting to order at 8:30am

Trustees in Attendance: Tom Otto, Helen Crandall via Skype, Joel Sietsema, Paul Kaczanowski, John Hellenberg, Todd Chwatun, Vicky Rigney, Alan Davis and Pastor Susan Webeler. The Trustees present constitute a quorum.

II. Approval of Meeting Minutes

John made a motion to approve the minutes as presented for the October 19, 2011 meeting.

Support by Vicky, all in favor.
THE MOTION CARRIED.

III. Treasurer's Report

Tom presented the bills to be paid and financial reports from October 2011. (Bank statements were not yet available.) After discussion, Alan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report and approve the payment of the bills as presented.

Support by Joel, all in favor.
THE MOTION CARRIED.

IV. Old Business

a. **Kitchen Dishwasher** – The under-counter dishwasher in the Fellowship Hall kitchen has finally died and now needs to be replaced. Vicky and Tom provided model and pricing information for the Trustees to review. After some discussion, it was decided that a Hobart brand, high temperature model with a detergent pump would be our best long term option. Joel made a motion to pursue the purchase of a Hobart

HOBSR24H4 dishwasher contingent on obtaining a funding source.

Support was given by Vicky and all were in favor. THE MOTION CARRIED.

The Trustees reviewed the Otsego County Community Foundation account statement indicating that there is a balance that can be used by the Church. A motion was made by Todd that these funds be used for the purchase of the dishwasher.

Support was given by John and all were in favor. THE MOTION CARRIED.

b. **Pledge Update** – Tom told the Trustees that so far there have been 20 pledge cards returned. This is down 6 cards from 2010. At this time, the returned pledges are \$1,900 short of the budgeted amount for 2012. Vicky is going to contact those Members who pledged last year, but have not turned in their pledge for 2012.

c. **Restroom Issues** – It was reported that Paul and Joel have replaced both toilets in the Ladies' Room and have installed toilet repair kits in the toilets in the Men's Room. Women's Fellowship is paying for the toilets in the Ladies' Room and has offered to pay the same amount for new toilets in the Men's Room if needed.

d. **Peace Pole Dedication** – Joel, Roy and Rod have removed the stump and

installed the peace pole between the church building and the pavilion. There will be a dedication ceremony performed on Sunday by the youth group.

e. **Church Signage** – It was reported that Vern will be creating the signs for the Church, but he is busy and there is no rush.

f. **Altar Railing** – Everyone agrees that there is a need for a railing in the chancel area to assist people walking up the steps. Paul and Joel have agreed to work together on this project.

g. Maintenance List

i. **Water Filter** - It was noted that the water filter under the hand sink in the kitchen needs to be replaced. Paul and Joel have agreed to perform this task when they work on their other projects.

ii. **Exterior Doors** – The exterior doors need a coat of paint, but this work will not be performed until next spring.

iii. **Lighting** – The fluorescent light fixtures in the Fellowship Hall are old and obsolete. When the bulbs and ballasts burn out, the entire fixture will need to be replaced. Research will be done to see if there are any pertinent grants available.

iv. **Storm Door** – The storm door at the Fellowship Hall entrance by the offices is in poor condition. The cost to replace the door is approximately \$180. Todd made a motion to purchase and install a new storm door costing up to \$200 from the Buildings & Grounds funds that are available.

Support was given by Vicky and all were in favor. THE MOTION CARRIED.

v. **Kitchen Telephone** – The phone in the kitchen is not working the way it is supposed to act. Joel volunteered to replace the phone to see if that will fix

the problem.

h. Sunday Offering Tally Sheet – The tally sheet used when counting the weekly offering has been revised to be more user friendly and accurate.

i. Counting & Deposit Training – Tom and John went through the steps involved in counting and depositing the weekly offering deposit.

V. New Business

Comstock Grant– Tom reported that the Comstock Grant that he applied for on behalf of the Church was turned down.

Pastor Susan – Pastor Susan requested that she be reimbursed for expenses related to her attendance at conference meetings. A motion was made by Joel to approve Pastor Susan's request.

Support was given by Vicky and all were in favor. THE MOTION CARRIED.

VI. Adjourn

At 10:55am, with no more business to come before the Trustees, the meeting was adjourned and Pastor Susan led the group in The Lord's Prayer.

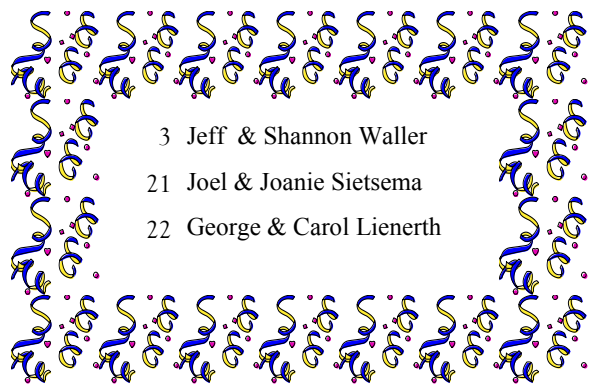
