MINISTER'S UPDATE

Convergence will be leading our church through a strategic planning process. The total cost for our church will be \$9,800, which has been approved by Trustees. The Michigan Conference of the United Church of Christ has approved our church for \$1,000, which is the first of several grants for which we have applied.

The Michigan Conference of the United Church of Christ offered to help in some way with disaster recovery after the ice storm.

- Greg suggested that the Michigan Conference help the Otsego County Food Pantry, as the need for their services in our community remains high. He also suggested Emergency Services at United Way.
- The Food Pantry will be having a fundraiser and food drive on Thursday evening, April 24th from 4:30 7:00 PM at the Gaylord Eagles Hall, with all proceeds benefiting the Otsego County Food Pantry.

DISCUSSION
