Not only are they tenacious but they are welcoming, of even the vandals who are invited to join them and see the love (and forgiveness) that is available when they follow the ways of Jesus.

The **local TV channel** picked up the story and interviewed several of the members of the church. Amy Frost and Mary Kohmuench reiterated the church's care for all, even the vandals.
