

	humble procession enters the city among the lives of the Jewish poor and marginalized.
Right Side:	(Facing left and stomping together) Entering through
	the gates, we ride in on horses with the powerful armor
	of Rome, bind the festal procession with power. Let the
	feast begin!
Left Side:	(Facing right and waving palms) Entering through the
	gates, Jesus comes riding on a donkey and the crowd
	binds the festal procession by laying down palm branches and shouting, "Hosanna!"
ALL:	(WAVING BRANCHES) OPEN TO US THE
	GATES OF GOD AND TOGETHER WE WILL
	PROCLAIM, "BLESSED IS THE ONE WHO
	COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD.
